1. Schedule Overview

SCO International Life Skill - SDGs Olympiad is conducted through three major annual cycles: Spring, Summer and Winter. Each cycle contains multiple online exam-date options so schools can select a date that aligns with academic calendars, internal assessments, local holidays, device availability and student readiness.

The schedule is designed for global participation. Students should follow the final date, time, login and proctoring instructions displayed in the SCO student portal or issued through the school-approved registration route.

Note for visitors: final live availability, school-specific allocation and student access are controlled through the official SCO portal. The published portal date and login page should always be treated as the final operational source for a student.

4. Recommended School Readiness Timeline

Timeline	Action for Schools and Students
4-6 weeks before exam	Confirm registrations, grade lists, device access, internet readiness and school communication.
3-4 weeks before exam	Begin guided revision using syllabus chapters, SDG notes, life-skill scenarios and practice worksheets.
1-2 weeks before exam	Conduct mock readiness checks: login, device, camera/microphone where applicable, proctoring instructions and time management.
Exam week	Share final instructions, date, time, login route, permitted materials and academic integrity rules.
After exam	Review reports, celebrate participation, identify learning gaps and plan next cycle participation.

5. Exam-Day Guidance

- Students must appear from the official SCO student login or school-issued exam route.
- Students should keep a stable internet connection and a quiet environment for the complete exam duration.
- The exam should be attempted only by the registered student; help from another person, device, website or AI tool is not permitted.
- Students should complete the exam within the allowed time and submit before leaving the exam page.
- Schools should complete device and login readiness before the selected date, especially for large batches.

6. Visitor-Friendly Cycle Labels

For clarity, Winter cycles may be displayed as two-year labels such as Winter 2026-27 or Winter 2027-28 where the academic journey, result publication or recognition timeline extends into the next calendar year. This avoids confusion for international schools and parents comparing calendar-year and academic-year schedules.
